This deed made this sixteenth day of September 1863 by Joseph Ennis Comptable of No. 12 Election District Frederick County, Maryland, Witnesseth, that by virtue of several Writs of Execution issued by Ezra L. Haro a Justice of the Peace of the County & State aforesaid and dated No 16th 1858 in the Cause of M. J. Groves Gittings & Willard and John Hightman vs. Alexander McDade the said Joseph Ennis as Comptable of said Dist in said County has sold to Ezra L Haro the following property beginning at a stone planted at the east side of the County Road leading from Burkittsville to Brownsville a corner of Tobias Horne & John Brown now George Horne, & running thence No. 71. N. 58 1/2 deg to a stone then N. 41 deg. 8 1/2 to a stone N. 12. E. 24 1/2 deg. to a stake then by a divisional line, S. 60 1/2 deg to 64 1/2 deg to a stone planted on the west side of said County Road then with the County Road, S. 31 1/4 deg N 14 1/3 deg to the Beginning containing 4 A. 2 Rods 200 perches of land more or less, now therefore the said Joseph Ennis do grant unto the said Ezra L. Haro all the right and title of Alexander McDade in and to said heretofore described property.
