At the Request of Emil Pfeifer the following deed was recorded August 21-1856. This Indenture made this first day of April Eighteen Hundred and fifty six between George W. Malone and Nellie Malone his wife of Frederick County, Maryland, of the one part and Emanuel Pfeifer of the aforesaid County and State of the other part - Witness, that the said Emanuel Pfeifer will hold this property in trust for Gabor and his wife he having become Surety, for them in two notes of hand bearing equal date with this instrument of writing, each of one hundred dollars payable in one and two years with interest from date so long as said notes are paid by said Gabor and wife or either of them then the property herein described shall vest in them and not before and said Pfeifer's Trustee shall cease. Therefore It is hereby Witnessed that for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and fifty dollars Current money by said Emanuel Pfeifer to the party of the second part in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge - the said party of the first part have bargained and sold, aliened and conveyed and by these presents do give grant, bargained and sell, aliened convey release, confirm and confirm unto the said Emanuel Pfeifer his heirs and assigns part of a tract of land called "Pfeifer's Timber Land" lying in Frederick County Maryland, Beginning for said part
