2. That the said Sarah Gaylor was in her life time indebted to your petitioner Charles W. Shidneck in the sum of One hundred and Fifty Five dollars and eighty five as will appear by reference to the account herewith filed and marked exhibit No. 1 for professional services rendered in her lifetime; and likewise indebted to your petitioner George W. Flook, in the sum of \$148.78 in her lifetime as per bill filed and marked exhibit No. 2. to this petition; and likewise indebted unto your petitioner Annie Gaylor, in her lifetime in the sum of \$104.25. as per bill rendered and filed herewith as exhibit No. 3. as well as to other individuals whose names and the amounts due each are unknown to petitioner.

3. That the whole of each said accounts are still due and owing to your petitioner.

4th. That the said Sarah Gaylor left no personal estate out of which the said several claims could be paid and satisfied.

5th That the original Bill of Complaints correctly described the heirs at law in whom said property vested, upon the death of the said Sarah Gaylor, subject however to the rights of petitioners and other creditors as a part of this petition, together with all other exhibits.

6th To the end therefore - That the proceeds arising from the sale of said property now in the hands of the said Frank L. Stoner, trustee in said cause, after the payment of the several claims of your petitioners as well as any other claimants that may come in and file their claims.

And for such other relief as the nature of their case may require. May it please your Honor to direct an order of publication to issue giving notice to Henry Gaylor, Susan Gaylor his wife, Elizabeth Gaylor, Ida Gaylor, Elmer Gaylor, Jennie Gaylor and Howard Gaylor infant all residents of the State of Indiana, and now residents of the State of Maryland, of the substance and object of this Bill of Complaints and warning them to appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein to show cause if any they have why a decree should not pass as prayed.
