Smith and J. Blanner Lane Sumner Trustees, to David Daniel and Benjamin Beck said deed being recorded in Liber 100 folio 262, of the Washington County Land Records a copy of said deed being filed herewith as a part hereof and marked Exhibit A.

The said David Beck and his wife and the said Benjamin Beck and his wife having on the 31st of March A.D. 1894, conveyed the undivided two third interest in said land to the said David Beck said deed being recorded in Liber 101 folio 596, of the said Washington County Land Records a copy of which is filed herewith as a part hereof and marked Exhibit B.

That several tracts or parcels of land that were conveyed to the said David Beck by Benjamin Beck and Fannie W. Beck his wife, by deed dated the 6th day of May A.D. 1876 and recorded in Liber No. 75 folio 25 of the said Washington County Land Records a copy of said deed being filed herewith as a part hereof and marked Exhibit C the tracts herein included being the first two tracts named in said deed and consisting of a tract containing about three acres and five perches of land located South of the town of Cavatone along the Tomson Road and the other containing one acre and one perch situated near
