at the appointed time and place proceed to take the following testimony to wit:-

The Plaintiffs filed with the Examiner as evidence Exhibit A. & B. which are herewith returned by the said Examiner.

Edward Orew, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff being Abely Spoon and examined, Mira Doe deposes and says as follows:-

My name is Edward Orew. I am 35 years of age and live near Liberty in Frederick County. I was the husband of Laura Hoy the decedent mentioned in this case. My wife died about eight years ago and left no will.

I knew Mary C. V. Hoy who was my wife's mother. She is also dead, having died about 1898 and leaving no will.

At the time of the death of Mary C. V. Hoy: She was seized and possessed of a tract of land of about fifteen acres near West Falls in Woodville District in Frederick County, improvements thereon, which she purchased from Thomas A. Kern by deed dated May 2, 1891, and duly recorded. I look at Exhibit A. filed with the bill in this case being the original deed, and that correctly describe said real estate.

The said Mary C. V. Hoy, at the time of her death left surviving her a husband Peter Hoy, who has since died and the following children, and grand-children as her only heir at law. Viz:-

A son, Vinton P. Hoy, who is married and both live in Frederick County.

A son Joseph Hoy who is married and whose wife's name is Nancy Hoy both of whom reside in Frederick County.

A son, Harry Hoy whose wife's name is Maggie both of whom live in Pittsburg, Pa.

A son, Daniel Grant Hoy, unmarried, who lives in Montgomery County.

A daughter Emma Woodrite, who is married and whose husband's name is Bernard Woodrite both of whom live in Leonard Co. Md. and a daughter, Laura wife of Edward Orew (the present witness) who died since her mother leaving her said husband and two children.

Viz:- Elizabeth Orew, who is an infant about 12 years of age, and Harne Orew, an infant about nine years
