Two thousand dollars of my Fredericton Savings Institution Stock, at this date also the interest arising from the sum of Two thousand dollars either in Real Estate, Bonds, Stock Notes, or Cash as the same may be invested at the time of my death, and after the death of my Sister Mary A. Steiner, I give devise and bequeath the said Two thousand dollars of Fredericton Savings Institution Stock, and also the said Two thousand dollars either in real estate bonds, stocks, notes or cash, as the same may be in hand at the time of my death to her children, or their children during their natural life and after their death to their children equally share and share alike. Should any of her children die without children then the remaining children shall be the legatees of this devise and bequest, and should the above devise of two thousand dollars be in real estate at the death of my Sister Mary A. Steiner I devise and bequeath the same to her sons to her children in common as joint tenants.

Second. I give devise and bequest to my Sister Henrietta, Hubert during her natural life, the one and a half story brick house and lot she now occupies, also the dividends or interest arising from two thousand dollars of my Fredericton Savings Institution Stock of this date also the interest from the sum of Five hundred dollars either in real estate, bonds, stocks, notes or cash as the same may be invested or on hand at the time of my death, and after the death of my Sister Henrietta Hubert, I give devise and bequest the said house and lot to her children in common as joint tenants during their life, the two thousand dollars of my Fredericton Savings Institution Stock and also the five hundred dollars either real estate, bonds, stocks, notes or cash as the same may be at the time of my death, to her children, during their natural life, and after ^{their} death, to their children, share and share alike. Should any of her children die, without leaving children, then the remaining children shall be the legatees of this devise and bequest should my Sister Henrietta, Hubert desire to repair or improve the dwelling house devised to her, it is my wish that she should use the five hundred dollars above devised for that purpose.

Third I give devise and bequest to my sister Elizabeth Brimmer, during her natural life my two brick house, which I now
