This Deed made this 18th day of March in the year
Nineteen Hundred and one by Mr. John Stoor of Frederick
County, Maryland.

Witnesseth, whereas by the last will
and testament of Ann Elizabeth Stoor, late of said
County, deceased, duly admitted to probate and
recorded in Liber F. N. W. NO 2, folios 122 &c, one
of the Will Records of said County, the said Testatrix
deceased and bequeathed to her husband Absolom Stoor
the use, improvement and income of the dwelling
house, lands, and their appurtenances, of said
Testatrix situated in Woodboro District in said County,
together with all her personal property of every kind
the said Absolom Stoor to have and hold the
same to him for and during his natural life,
with the power to sell the said dwelling house
and lot during his lifetime, as well as said
personal property, and divide the proceeds among
the children in equal shares, and Testatrix then
deceased and bequeathed to her eight children,
hereinafter named, then living, the reversion of
said dwelling house, lands and their appur-
tenances, and all profits, income and advan-
tages that may result therefrom, from and
after the decease of her said husband, and
said Testatrix directed in said Will all of said
property to be sold after the decease of her
said husband and divided in equal shares
among the said eight children, or the
survivors of them at the decease of her said
husband including the heirs of any of the
children dying before the said husband of said
Testatrix, and George C. Stoor was named in said
will as the Executor thereof, and
