In pursuance of the annexed order of the Court and notice given me by the Solicitor for the Plaintiff in the above entitled cause I belchton O. Needy, one of the regular Examiners of said Court, duly appointed, qualified and sworn, having assigned the 5th day of October A.D. 1906 at the office of John S. Quoman Esq. in Frederick City, Md. as the time and place for taking the testimony in this cause and having given due notice thereof to the parties concerned, did at the appointed time and place proceed to take the following testimony, to wit: -

The Plaintiff filed with the Examiner as evidence Exhibits A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, W, X, Y, Z, and "A. A. W" which are herewith returned by the said Examiner.

Preston C. Miller, a witness of lawful age produces on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn, and examined depones and says as follows:  
1st Int State your name, age, residence and occupation)

Ans Preston C. Miller: 65 years. Sandy Hook, Washington Co. Md. I am a Surveyor.

2d Int Did you during the lifetime of Mrs Susan A Kenner Survey for her and her husband, was a Kenner any land lying in and near Brunswick in this County.

Ans Yes Sir. I made several Surveys. I made one Survey of her whole farm, and several times I laid off lots on the East Side of the property

3d Int Did you on Dec. 9th 1893. Survey for Mr Kenner her farm adjacent to the town of Brunswick?

Ans Yes.

4th Int Look at the plat now shown you and Exhibit filed as Exhibit J. C. M. No. 1. and state whether or not that is the plat of that Survey.

Ans Yes Sir that is correct.

5th Int Have you the original notes showing the courses and distances of this Survey?

Ans I have not.

6th Int Can you state the quantity of land lying within the outlines of said plat, westwardly of the 3 lines running in a N. W. direction of 48. per 72 1/4 + 52 1/4 per aggregating 174 1/2

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
