Ques. How did you find the farm to contain?

Ans. 8<sup>th</sup> St.

152 A. R. + 29 perches.

Do the outlines of the farm as shown on your plat truly represent the outlines of the farm?

Ans. 9<sup>th</sup> St.

They do.

I notice the S.E. corner of your plat certain lots laid off and numbered from 64 to 81, lying immediately west of what you have designated as Third Avenue, what do these represent?

Ans.

They represent an addition made by Mrs. Kenner prior to her death to the lots formerly laid off by her and designated "H.H. Kenner's First addition to Brunswick with additions thereto" and are the same as the lots of the same numbers shown on the Plat heretofore filed in this cause as Exhibit "P. E. W. No. 2"

Where does the B. & O. Railroad run with reference to your plat?

Ans.

11<sup>th</sup> St.

Along the whole Southern margin thereof I noted on your Plat you have laid off by dotted lines a parcel of land containing  $\frac{20}{100}$  Acrey which you have marked "H.H. Kenner et al. B. & O. Rail Road Co" what does that represent?

Ans.

That represents the land that was sold and conveyed to the B. & O. R. Co. H.H. Kenner et al. by deed dated June 1st, 1906, and recorded in Liber S.H. No. 2044 fol. 547.

12<sup>th</sup> St.

Immediately east of that parcel I find you have laid off by dotted lines a small parcel of ground which you have designated, "H.H. Kenner et al. to Roy B. Kenner" what does this represent?

Ans.

It represents the land conveyed by H.H. Kenner et al. to Roy B. Kenner, by deed dated Jan. 28, 1906 and recorded in S.H. No. 276, fol. 3.

13<sup>th</sup> St.

And immediately east of this latter parcel I find you have laid off a small parcel extending eastwardly to lots 67 and 71 and from the B. & O. R. on the South to the Road to Knoxville on the North which you have designated "Brunswick Canning Co." what does this represent?

Ans.

This represents a conveyance made by me for the Brunswick Canning Company of land which they have purchased, or are about to purchase from the Kenners.
