The Bill of Complaint of William M. Popst of Frederick County Maryland, Plaintiff, who sues for himself as well as all other Creditors of William S. Ray, late of said County, deceased, who may come in and contribute to the expense of these proceedings against Alice C Ray, Administratrix of the personal estate of William S Ray, deceased Alice C. Ray, widow, Maud Ray, Willie S Ray, Mattie E. Ray, Ira F Ray, Nellie J Ray, C. Walter Ray, Mary A. Ray, George Amner Ray, All infants, and Charles W. Zimmerman, assignee of Franklin Buchanan Smith, and Emma J Smith, Mortgagee, defendants in your Honorable Court exhibited, respectfully shews,

I. That the Plaintiff is an adult and resides in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland. That all the defendants are also residents of said Frederick County Maryland, and are also all infants with the exception of Alice C. Ray, and Charles W. Zimmerman who are both adults.

2. That William S. Ray, being of said Frederick County, died testate at said County, on or about the 23rd day of December, A D 1905.
