To the Honorable: the Judges of Said Court:-
The Bill of Complaint of Charles L. McColgan,
Trustee of Maria Woodward Miller, in the place
and stead of Maria Walters Blunt Miller, deceased
under the terms of the last will and testament
of S. Francis Miller the Certi- que- trust under
the terms of said last will and testament of
S. Francis Miller, deceased, respectfully shew
unto your Honors:-

1st - That a certain S. Francis Miller, late
of Howard County, and State of Maryland
was in his lifetime seized and possessed of
dwelling house and lot of ground situate,
lying and being on North Market Street in the
City of Frederick, Frederick County, and State
of Maryland now known and designated as
Nos 123 and 125 North Market Street in
said City of Frederick it being the same
dwelling house and lot of ground which
the said S. Francis Miller obtained by devise
under the terms of the last will and
testament of Charles M. Miller late of Frederick
County, and State of Maryland, deceased
as will appear by reference to a certified
copy of said last will and testament of Charles
M. Miller, deceased, filed herewith and
marked Exhibit No. 1, which together with all
other exhibits herewith filed it is prayed
may be taken and considered as a part
hereof the same as if fully set forth in
words and figures.

2nd - That the said S. Francis Miller,
being so seized and possessed of the said
dwelling house and lot of ground as aforesaid
departed this life at Howard County in the
State of Maryland on or about the year
A. D. 1897, leaving a last will and testa-
ment, which said last will and testament
of S. Francis Miller, was duly admitted to
probate in the orphan Court for Howard County, Maryland
on or about July 3rd, A. D. 1897, and certified copy of
which said last will and testament of S. Francis Miller
has been heretofore duly recorded in Liber C. E. S. No. 1,
folio 264 et seq one of the records books for file in the
office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, Maryland,
a duly certified copy of which said last will and testament
of S. Francis Miller is herewith filed and is marked
Exhibit No. 2.
