At the request of Catherine Sutton the following deed is recorded the 18th day of April 1836.

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of April in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty five, between Mary Howell of Frederick County Maryland of the one part, and Catherine Sutton of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witness, that for and in Consideration of the sum of Eighty five Dollars Current Money to the said Mary Howell by the said Catherine Sutton in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and her to be deemed fully satisfied, Contented and paid, the said Mary Howell, hath bargained and sold, aliened and conveyed and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell alien, convey, release and confirm unto the said Catherine Sutton her heirs and assigns all that part of a lot of ground lying and being in the town of Emmitsburg County, & State aforesaid being part of a front lot known & distinguished on the plat of said town by Number one hundred and fifteen, viz: beginning for said part at Number one hundred & fourteen and running with the front Street of Emmitsburg thirty feet thence to the back alley parallel with the line of said lots, thence thirty feet to said lot
