for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity,
Your Orators R. B. Raudle, and Noah Barnes Complainants
respectfully represents unto your Honor:-
1st. That a certain John Le Biddinger, late of Frederick
County deceased died during the month of December
in the year A. D. 1906 leaving a Last Will
and Testament, which has been duly shown and
admitted to probate by the orphan court for
Frederick County, a Certified Copy of which is herewith
filed herewith marked exhibit No. 1. to this Bill of
Complaint which together with all other exhibits Complai-
nants pray may be taken and considered as
a part hereof

2nd. That the said John Le Biddinger was
at the time of his death seized of a
tract or parcel of real estate situate in
Frederick County, described in a deed
from James M. Rice Administrator to Jas.

Folio. 573. a Certified Copy of which is herewith
filed and marked exhibit No. 2. to this Bill
of Complaint.

3rd. That the estate of the said John Le Biddinger
is indebted to Complainants R. B. Raudle in
the sum of Twenty Four Dollars for her burial
expenses, to Complainant Noah Barnes in the
sum of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents for
Merchandise furnished in the life time of
the deceased, said accounts showing the
amounts so due and owing being filed
