the direction of your honorable Court, of the said
debts, so as aforesaid due to your Masters, and of all
other debts which were due and owing by the said
John H. Biddinger at the time of his death,
and what still remain unpaid, of the
personal property, of the said intestate received
by or for the use of the said F. W. Maynard,
Administrator aforesaid
- (3.) That said personal estate may be applied in due
course of Administration in payment of the debts
of the intestate due your Masters and all other
creditors who may come in and contribute to the
