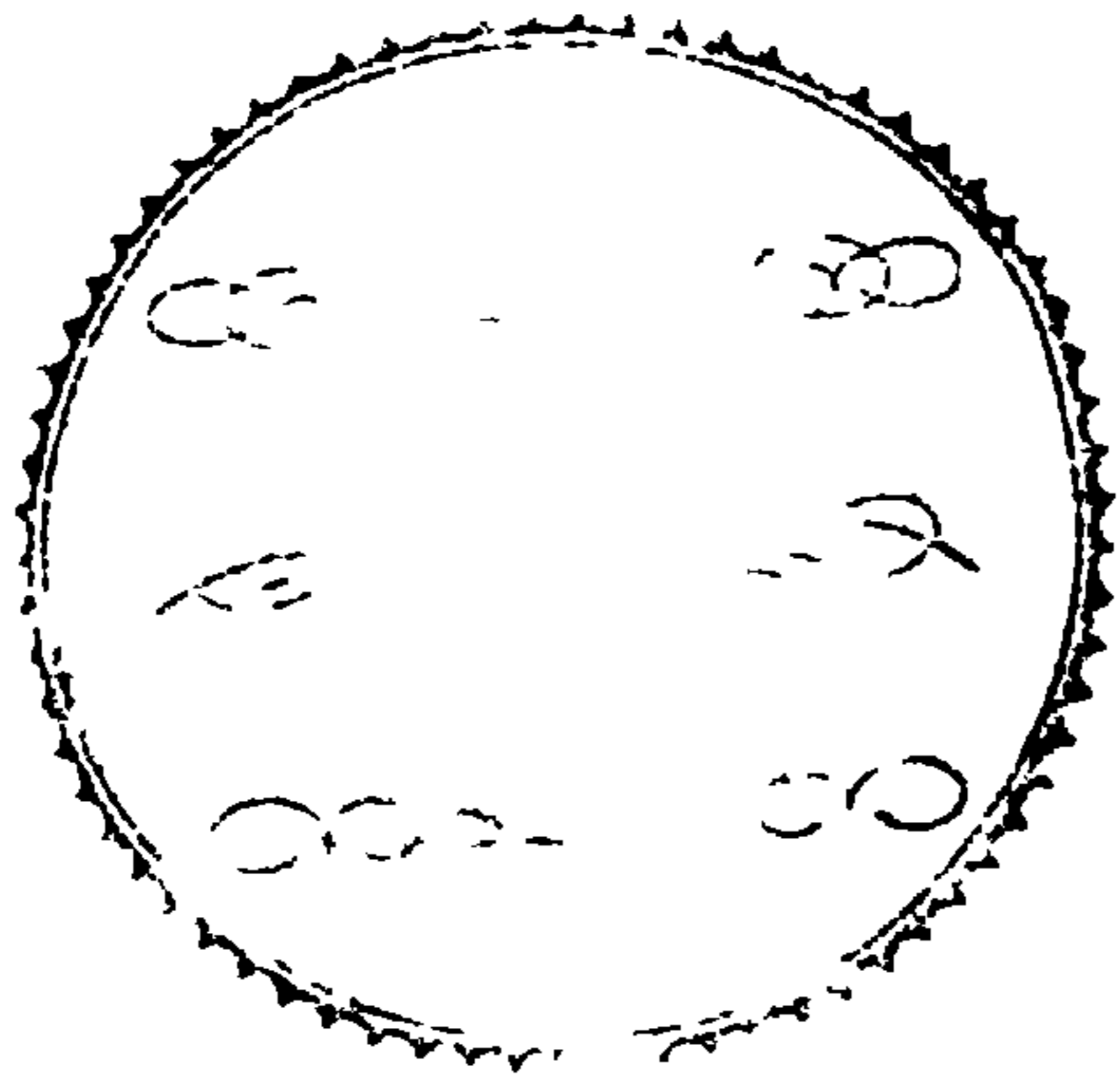

This deed made this eighteenth day of December, in the year nineteen hundred and two by James M. Rice, Administrator of Reuben G. H. Rice, deceased, Assignee of Mortgage, Witnesseth: - that whereas Noah Barnes and Louisa E. Barnes his wife did on March 25th, 1871, execute to Francis J. Starns a Mortgage on a lot in New London Frederick County, State of Maryland, which lot was fully described therein and which was recorded in Liber L. M. No. 7, Folio 39, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, State of Maryland, and whereas said Mortgage was duly assigned to Reuben G. H. Rice, deceased in his life time, and whereas now made in the payment of the said Mortgage and James M. Rice administrator of Reuben G. H.
