This Mortgage, made this 1st day of April Eighteen hundred and Seventy one by Loyd Lorauppton Ellen Lorauppton his wife of Frederick County State of Maryland.

Witnessed that the said Loyd Lorauppton by my Single Bill bearing date the 1st day of April 1871. for Two Hundred and forty five dollars payable three months after date with interest. stand indebted to the said George W. Smith of the County and state aforesaid, and to secure to the said George W. Smith the pay of the said Two Hundred and forty five dollars, with interest thereon according to the tenor and effect of the Single Bill above recited I the said Loyd Lorauppton and Ellen Lorauppton do grant in fee simple unto the said George W. Smith all that part or parcel of land called Reservoir on Daniel Small tract. Situated in Frederick County, Maryland and containing six and three quarters, more or less it being the same land which was conveyed to the said Loyd Lorauppton by Gideon Tussard & Ann L. Tussard by deed dated the 27th day of March 1871. provided that if the said Loyd Lorauppton shall pay to the said Geo. W. Smith, the sum of Two Hundred and forty five dollars according to the tenor and effect of the Single bill above recited, then the mortgage shall be void.
