

NO. 8161 Equity.

The Petition of Susan J. Lowe, Mortgagee of Mary E. G. Plummer respectfully represents unto your Honors:-
 1. That on the date April 30th 1896, your Petitioner loaned to the said Mary E. G. Plummer the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, current money, and received from her the single bill of said Mary E. G. Plummer dated April 30th 1896, for said sum of \$250. payable twelve months after that date with interest from date as will appear by single bill herewith filed as a part herof and marked "Exhibit M. E. G. P."

2. That to secure the repayment of said single bill the said Mary E. G. Plummer executed and delivered to your Petitioner her deed of Mortgage of some date, which Mortgage covered the same real estate as covered by the "Exhibit P" heretofore filed in this cause, and being a second lien thereon, and which said second Mortgage lien as recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 13, folios 332 etc., one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, is herewith filed as a part herof and marked "Exhibit P. J. L."

3. That all of said sum of \$250.00 with interest thereon since said date April 30th 1896, is due and owing unto your Petitioner excepting only the sum of \$25. as paid thereon by the said Mary E. G. Plummer to your Petitioner on the date March 8th in the year 1905.

Therefore your Petitioner prays:-
 That your Honor will direct the Auditor of your Honorable Court to allow unto your Petitioner in any statement of account he may hereafter render in this cause an allowance to your Petitioner for said sum of \$200. with interest thereon from the date April 30th in the year 1896, less the sum of \$25. as paid to your Petitioner on the date March 8th in the year 1905.
