This Mortgage made this twenty fourth day of April in the year eighteen hundred and eighty six by us Samuel W. Plummer and Mary E. G. Plummer, his wife, Witnessed that for and in Consideration of five hundred dollars now due from us the said Samuel W. Plummer and Mary E. G. Plummer, his wife, to Susan J. Lowe, which sum of five hundred dollars was borrowed from the said Susan J. Lowe by the said Mary E. G. Plummer to pay off the balance due by her on two Mortgages given to Col. Lyde Griffith of Montgomery County, as held by him under assignments and now in the hands of his executor, on her sole and separate real estate, We, the said Samuel W. Plummer and Mary E. G. Plummer his wife do grant unto the said Susan J. Lowe all that piece, parcel or tract of land wherever we now reside, situated in Frederick County, State of Maryland adjoining the lands of Anna Mary Wood and others being part of a tract of land called the Addition to the reservoir on four tracts, it also being part of that tract of land that was deeded to Philiman Griffith, by Josh Waters, and Beginning for the outlines thereof, as described in the Deed in No. 3317 Equity in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity which was a proceeding to lay off, and divide certain lands between
