And I do further order and direct and my will is that all the rest residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed, shall be sold, and all debts due to me cleared and the whole amount, together with the money on hand shall be equally divided between my wife Charlotte my son Greenburg, Grafton, and David H. and my daughter Rebecca and Mary Ann share and share alike, in equal proportions, and lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint George Foot, and my son Greenburg Foot sole executors of this my last will and testament revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament.

I witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 9th. day of January in the year our Lord Eighteen Hundred and thirty nine.
