I Baltzer Fout being desirous to make some provision in behalf of my Slaves do therefore - this as a Codicil to my last will and testament which I executed during the present year and placed in the hands of John H. MacElphink Esqr. for safe keeping - It is my will and I so order and direct that my slaves Abraham, Jane and Aaron be sold by my executors to serve ten years from the time of my decease and that they be respectively manumitted, at the end of said term of ten years, and that the issue of Jane be free at the age of thirty one years.

Witness my hand and seal this twentieth day of March 1839.
