Came Henry Hester and made oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God, that he did see Baltzer Fout the testator therein named, sign and seal the foregoing Codicil that he heard him publicly pronounce and declare the same to be a Codicil to his last will and testament, that at the time of his so doing he was to the best of his apprehension of a sound and disposing mind memory and understanding, and that he subscribed his name as a witness thereto at the request of the testator and in his presence.
