



NO. 8117 Equity.

Worthan and Ann Elizabeth Worthan his wife and their heirs and assigns forever, all that part of a tract or parcel of land, situate lying and being in the County, and State aforesaid, being part of a tract of land called "The Fish", or be it part of any other tract whatsoever, Beginning for the same at a stone formerly planted at the end of the 3rd or N. $8\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. $99\frac{1}{4}$ ft. line of Daniel Scherer's as shown in 1835, for $104\frac{1}{4}$ acres, then running by and with said 3rd line reversed connecting the same to agree with the original location S. $6\frac{5}{8}^{\circ}$ E. $99\frac{1}{4}$ ft. to a stone at the end of the 2nd line of said $104\frac{1}{4}$ acres, then S. $82\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 14 ft. to the middle of the public road, it being on the 10th, or S. $7\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 199 ft. line of a tract of land, called "Keefer's Prospect", then with said 10th line reversed connecting the same and the middle of the said road N. $70\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. $72\frac{3}{4}$ ft. then N. 25° W. 35 ft. to a large locust post, S. 12° W. 4 ft. to the place of Beginning, containing about seven acres, one rood, and six perches of land, together with all and singular, the buildings, improvements, ways, waters, water courses, rights, members, privileges, advantages and appurtenances, thereto belonging, or in any way appertaining, and all the estate right, title, and interest, trust, property, claim and demand whatsoever, at law and equity, of them the said Grafton Foot and Loretta Foot, his wife, of, in and to the same.
