 That the said Elizabeth Morrison left surviving her a husband Arthur Morrison who is now also dead, and the following heirs at law, to whom the same descend, as tenant in common viz: - a brother John T. Oker whose wife's name is Ann, a brother George A. Oker whose wife's name is Sarah, a sister, Mary Bishop whose husband is dead, a sister Louisa Buffington whose husband is also dead, and the following sons and daughters of Kattie Fess deceased, whose husband is also dead viz: William H. Fess whose wife's name is Louisa E. Meade Fess, whose wife's name is Catherine, Albert Fess whose wife's name is Carrie, Albert Fess whose wife's name is Margaret, Ezra Fess whose wife's name is Sarah, Missouri Cook whose husband's name is Charles, Catherine Edwards whose husband's name is Francis, and Jennie Toxell whose husband's name is Henry and also a sister Catherine Forney whose husband's name is Herman, but if now living or dead your orators do not know, nor know the names of their heirs if any.

That all are adults over twenty one years of age and reside in Frederick County, Maryland, except Mary Bishop and Louisa Buffington, both of whom reside in Carroll County, Maryland, and Albert Fess, and Margaret Fess his wife who reside in Baltimore County Maryland, and Ezra Fess and Sarah Fess his wife who now reside in the State of Kansas, Missouri, whose husband's name is Charles, who reside in the State of New York, Catherine Edwards and Francis her husband who reside in the State of California, and Jennie Toxell and Henry her husband both of whom reside in the State of New York, and Catherine Forney and Herman her husband, both of whom reside in some State in the West, whose last names from, but if now living or not is unknown nor if dead the names of their heirs if they left any.

The Bill then prays for the following relief and process.

That a decree may be granted for the sale of the said real estate, and that the proceeds thereof be divided among the heirs at law, and for such other and further relief, as may be necessary in the premises.

And that the writ of Subpoena may issue in the usual form against the non residents defendants.
