Elizabeth Morrison at the time of her death was seized and possessed of about 2 1/2 acres of land situated in Frederick County, Md. and which is correctly described in "Exhibit C. W." now shown me. It having been conveyed to her under her maiden name of Elizabeth Okler, before her marriage to Reuben Morrison. The property is worth \$8000.

The said real estate is not susceptible of division among the parties without loss and injury because it is too small to be divided into so many parts and has but one set of buildings on it.
