To the end therefore, that an account may be taken of the said Trust Estate as administered by your orator, by and before the Auditor of this Court, with power to take testimony thereon if necessary, a due allowance for the expenses, charges and trouble therein had by your orator, and that the said John R. Mills be decreed by your Honor to Convey the said lands hereinbefore conveyed to him by the said James Pease & Deborah Pease and paid for out of the Trust funds of the said Trusteeship by your orator to enable your orator to close up and settle his said trusteeship, and that your orator may upon the settlement of his accounts as hereinbefore prayed before the Auditor of this Court, be discharged from the trusts trusts of the said deed of trust, and be authorized to convey the real estate held under the said trust and the personal estate thereof to such person or persons as your Honor may decree and deem proper to appoint, retaining and reserving out of the said funds the reasonable costs charges, and allowance to your orator for his trouble therein, and for his costs therein and, that the defendants hereinafter named may answer the several matters and things herein set forth as fully and particularly as if the same were herein again repeated and they were thereunto specially interrogated and that your orator may have such other and further relief as his case may require.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your orator the writ of Subpoena against the said John R. Mills and Rachel B. Mills his wife, Pauline Mills and Howard Mills commanding them to be and appear at this Court at some day certain to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein, and as in duty bound he will ever pray &c.
