of the Complainant, being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with me by the solicitor for the Complainant and herewith returned deposes and says. To the 1st. Interrogatory, I know them all, and have known them many years, the children since their birth. The Complainant, Greenbury R. Sappington is trustee named in these proceedings. The Defendants John R. Mills and Rachel B. Mills are husband and wife, and their children, the infant defendants, Pauline, Alberta, & Howard their ^{only} children.

To the 2nd Interrogatory, I have answered this interrogatory in my answer to the 1st. Interrogatory.

To the 3rd Interrogatory, John R. Mills & Rachel B. Mills were married in 1850. Her name before marriage was Rachel Baker Frame.

To the 4th Interrogatory, I know that Rachel B. Mills prior to her marriage was seized and possessed of certain real and personal properties as stated & mentioned in Exhibit A. in this case. They are.

To the 5th Interrogatory, I am acquainted with the Land writing of John R. & Rachel B. Mills, and the signature to Exhibits Marked No. 1. to 13. are genuine.

To the 6th. Interrogatory, waived as to this ~~witness~~.
To the 7th. Interrogatory, they did until the said lands were sold.

To the 8th Interrogatory, A part of said lands were sold to Levi J. Barnes. I do not know what became of the proceeds of said lands.

The 9th. & 10th. - 11th. Interrogatories, and 12th Interrogatory, waived as to this witness, as also the 13th Interrogatory. To 1st. Special Interrogatory, Mr. Greenbury R. Sappington trustee in this case, did pay as trustee of Joshua Frame deceased, purchase money of a tract of land, and out of the trust funds of this estate, and I conveyed the lands to John R. Mills. The amount of the purchase so paid and the description of the lands by me conveyed to John R. Mills are obtained and set forth in paper marked Exhibit B. now shown to me as Exhibit B. in this case.

To the 2nd Interrogatory, I did thereafter sell to John R. Mills, a certain tract of land containing one hundred and one acres of land, for one thousand dollars an acre. Greenbury R. Sappington as trustee paid \$6500. of the purchase money on said tract of land, and the balance and interest thereon, except about \$40. remains unpaid. I have
