1. That the Plaintiffs are residents of Frederick County,
Maryland, that the defendant William S. Noice and
Margaret S. Noice his wife, respectfully shews unto
your Honor:

1. That the Plaintiffs are both adults and are residents
of Frederick County, Maryland; that the defendants William
S. and Ellen Noice his wife are both adults and non-residents
of the State of Maryland, residing in the State of Ohio
and the defendant Penn S. Hoark is an adult and a
resident of said Frederick County, Maryland.

2. That on the 3rd day of June A. D. 1905, one George
W. Noice late of Frederick County, deceased, departed this
life seized and possessed of certain real estate situated
in said Frederick County, Maryland, being the same
real estate which is described in a deed from George
W. Noice, Trustee, to the said George W. Noice dated May
6th, A. D. 1876, and recorded in Liber T. G. No. 5, folios
315, & 316, one of the Land Records of said Frederick County,
