

No. 7991. Equity

Said real estate to be sold, and after the payment of all costs, charges and expenses attending said sale, and of the mortgage debt principal and interest upon said real estate, the proceeds to be divided among the above mentioned owners thereof.

Second. That the Plaintiffs may have all such other and further and general relief as the nature of their case may require.

And the Plaintiffs pray for the following

Process:

(1). That your Honors may grant unto your Orators the writ of Subpoena directed to the said Penn S. Corp., assignee of Margaret Hamburg Mortgage, commanding him to be and appear in your Honorable Court, on or before some certain day to be mentioned therein to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.

(2). That your Honors may also grant unto your Orators an order of Publication, giving notice to the non-resident Defendants the State of Maryland the said William S. Strie and Ellen Strie, of the object and the substance of this Bill, and commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein, to answer said Bill and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed in the premises.
