To the Honorable, The Judge of Said Court:-
The Bill of Complaint of Sophia J. Michael of Frederick County, Maryland, who sues for herself as well as all other Creditors of George W. Krise, deceased late of said County, who may come in and contribute to the expense of these proceedings against Charles H. Krise, Administrator of said George W. Krise and Ellen Krise his wife all Defendants in your Honorable Court Exhibited respectfully. Shows.

1st. That the Plaintiff is an adult, residing in said Frederick County, as likewise are all the Defendants adults and also residing in said County with the exception of William S. Krise and Ellen Krise his wife who reside in the State of Ohio.

2nd. That on June 3rd 1905, one George W. Krise, late of said Frederick County, died at said County, intestate, leaving a personal estate as well as certain real estate, which has been sold in these proceedings by Trustee, appointed by your Honorable Court, as by reference to the previous proceedings in this case, will fully appear.

3rd. That Charles H. Krise one of the Defendants in this case, administered upon said personal estate, in the Orphan Court, of said County, and has settled his account in said Orphan Court. That there was a deficiency of personal assets in the settlement of said account, and a note of said George W. Krise, which your Petitioner proved in said Court, and which were a party to the indebtedness of said George W. Krise at the time of his death for \$145.00 with interest from April 23rd, 1902, at the rate of five per cent is due and owing, as will appear by Exhibit "A" herewith filed.

4th. That there being a deficiency in the personal estate of said George W. Krise, and there ^{now} being in the hands of the Trustee Am S. Harp & Co. Sorey Etchings in this case, a sum of money above all costs, & expenses incurred in the sale of the real estate of said George W. Krise and the mortgage indebtedness against said real estate, of between five and six hundred dollars, your Petitioner has
