the right to have the right to have the amount due her upon said note, paid out of the surplus funds in the hands of said Trustees, awaiting distribution under further orders of your Honorable Court among the two heirs at law of said George W. Noice.

And your Petitioner prays for the following relief

1st. That an order or decree may be passed by your Honorable Court, authorizing the Trustees in this cause who hold in their hands the surplus funds for distribution, for the sale of the real estate in this cause to pay your Petitioner the amount of the note filed with the Petition principal and interest from April 23rd. A. D. 1902, out of said surplus funds

2nd. That your Petitioner shall have such other further relief as the nature of her case may require.

And your Petitioner prays for the following process:-

1st. That a summons may be issued in the usual form directed to Charles H. Noice Administrator, and Charles H. Noice individually & Margaret S. Noice, his wife, of Indiana County, in order that they may answer the matters & things herein stated, commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein, either in person or by solicitor, to answer the premises & abide by & perform such decree as may be passed therein.

2nd. That an order of publication may be issued, giving notice to the non-resident defendants, the said William S. Noice & Ellen Noice his wife, notifying them of the object & substance of this Petition, & commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein; to answer said Petition and abide by and perform such decree or order as may be passed in the premises.
