

No 7941 Equity.

The object of the bill, filed in the above entitled Cause by Sophia J. Michael, is to procure a decree authorizing the Trustees in Said Cause to pay the petitioners the amount due on a certain note of one George W. Krise, deceased out of surplus funds in their hands from the sale of the real estate of George W. Krise, their being a deficiency in his personal estate.

The Bill states,

1st. That all the parties are adults, & residents of Frederick's County, Maryland, excepting, William S. Krise and Ellen Krise, who resides in Ohio.

2nd. That on June 3rd, 1905, George W. Krise, leaving a personal estate, as well as certain real estate which has been sold by Trustees under the guidance of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as by reference to said proceedings heretofore had, will fully appear.

3rd. That Charles S. Krise, one of the above named defendants administered upon the personal estate of said George W. Krise, in the Orphans Court of said Frederick County, that there was a deficiency of personal assets in the Settlement of his account and a certain note given to the petitioner, in this bill by said George W. Krise, deceased, on April 3rd, 1902 for \$145.00, with interest from date at five per cent per annum, is still owing and unpaid, as will appear by said note filed as Exhibit "N".

4th. That there being a deficiency in the personal estate, and there now being in the hands of the Trustees, Rens S. Karp and H. Dorsey Critchison in this cause who sold the real estate, a surplus fund for distribution among the heirs at law of said George W. Krise deceased of between five and six thousand dollars after the payment of all debts charges, and expenses attending the sale of said real estate, and the payment is full of the mortgage indebtedness on same the petitioner has the right to have the due her on said note paid out of said said surplus fund.

The bill then prays for an order or decree authorizing the said trustees to pay
