The bill then prays for such other and further relief as the nature of her case may require for a summons directed to Charles H. Krise, Administrator et al., Charles H. Krise, individually and Margaret A. Krise his wife, commanding them to be and appear in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, on some certain day to be named therein to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein; and for an order of Publication against the non-resident defendants William S. Krise and Ellen Krise his wife notifying them of the object and substance of the bill, and commanding them to be and appear in said Court on some certain day to be named therein, to answer said bill and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed in the premises.

It is therefore this 20th day of March, A. D. 1907, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ordered and adjudged that the plaintiff, by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in said Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks prior to the 20th day of April A. D. 1907, give notice to the said William S. Krise and Ellen Krise his wife, the non-resident defendants, of the object and substance of this bill, and warn them to be and appear in this Court on or before the 20th day of April A. D. 1907, to answer the said bill and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed in the premises.
