Witness that in consideration of one hundred dollars, the receipt of which sum is hereby acknowledged as paid in full the said A. J. Baker, and Hannah M. Baker, his wife do grant unto Francis Ann Mullineux of Montgomery County, or to her heirs and assigns in fee simple, all that piece or parcel of ground situate lying and being in Frederick County Maryland aforesaid, and described as follows, to-wit: - Beginning for the same at the South-west corner of Minrod Smith's lot, in the Village of Mt. Airy, Md., in the middle of Avenue and running thence bounding on said lot North
