The above cause being at issue and a notice having been given me by the Solicitor for the Plaintiffs of a desire to take testimony in said cause, having been first had and obtained, J. M. Q. 2nd Who was Francis Mullins?
Ans. She was my first wife -

Q. 3rd. Is she living or dead, if dead when did she die?

Ans. She is dead and died 27th of November 1903.

Q. 4th Did she die seized of any real estate?

Ans. Yes Sir she owned some real estate. I look at two deeds marked Exhibit No. 1, and they correctly described the property.

Q. 5th Who did the said Francis A. Mullins leave Seizing her as her heirs at law, and in whom the property described in Exhibit No. 1. Vest at the time of her death?
