The above cause standing ready for a hearing,
and being submitted, the Bill, Answer, Exhibits and
affidavit, Petition of Mrs. Willberger and answer thereto
and all other proceedings were by the Court read and
considered.

It is thereupon, this 6th day of July in the year
Nineteen Hundred and three by the Circuit Court for
Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the
authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered, and decreed,
that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings
