I Lavinia S. Wilkide of Frederick County, Maryland, being of sound mind, memory and understanding, considering the uncertainty of life & that I may the better be prepared to leave this world do therefore make this my last will and testament.

First. I order and direct my Executor to be hereafter named as soon after my decease as practicable to pay off & discharge all debts that may exist against me at the time of my decease.

Second. I direct my executor some years after my decease to see at public sale the farm upon which I now reside and the proceeds of said sale to be equally divided share and share alike in trust to my three sons, viz: Peter A. Wilkide, John C. Wilkide & George W. Wilkide.

Third. I direct my executor to hold the legacy of each of these my sons in trust & such legacy to be expended solely for the purpose of a home, and should such a purchase after a reasonable time not be agreeable to either legatee or executor then with the mutual consent of both the property or home can be sold & the proceeds of such sale applied to the purchase of an other.

Fourth. I give to my dear husband, M. Wilkide, absolutely all my personal property, and the release of a note of Four Hundred dollars with the interest thereon, which I hold against him by the payment at the end of three year from my decease, to each of my three sons previously named, the sum of one hundred dollars each.
