To the Honorable the Judges of Said Court:-
 Your orator, who sues as well for himself as for
 all other Creditors of Margaret Ann Stone, late of
 Frederick County, deceased, who will come in and
 contribute to the expenses of this Suit, Complaining,
 Says:-

1. That Said Margaret Ann Stone departed
 this life, interstate, in Frederick County, Maryland
 on or about July 14, 1905, being at and before the
 date of her Said death the widow of Scott F.
 Stone, who died, about two years ago, leaving
 as her only child and heir at law her Son
 living, a Son, Scott F. Stone, who is a minor about
 one year old.

2. That the Said Margaret Ann Stone was
 in her lifetime and at the time of her death,
 indebted unto your orator, the Said William
 E. Adams, in the full and just of one
 hundred and eighty dollars, upon an
 open account, dated July 14, 1905, for boarding,
 washing, nursing and attention to and for
 her from May 16, 1905, to July 14, 1905, both
 inclusive, in Frederick City, Frederick County,
 Maryland, which account is filed herewith
 as Exhibit No. 1, to this bill of Complaint, which exhibit
 together with all other exhibits herewith filed, is
 prayed to be taken and considered as a part of
 this Bill of Complaint.

3. That the Said Margaret Ann Stone, being so
 indebted as aforesaid unto your orator and
