Russell and Elizabeth S. his wife of the City of Woodbury and State of New Jersey of the the first part, and Margaret C. Harding of the County, and State of Maryland of the second part: Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part for and in Consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars lawful money of the United States of America well and truly paid by the said party of the second part to the said parties of the first part, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, all the following described parcel of land in sixth election district
