Frizzell of Baltimore City, in the State of Maryland, Witness, that in Consideration of the Sum of Five Hundred and Fifty dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I, the said Berthia O. Frizzell, do hereby grant assign and convey unto Raymond L. Frizzell of said City and State, all my down right, title and interest in and to all the real estate in Frederick County, Maryland, of which my wife Mary Cora Frizzell, died seized, being the following tracts or parcels of land, to-wit: - All that tract of land containing fifty-two acres, more or less, situated in said County and conveyed to the said Mary Cora Frizzell by William L. Beall and Themas L. Beall his wife, by deed dated October 19th, 1899, and recorded in Liber L. & N. C. No. 5, folio 268, one of the land records of said County, and all that tract of land containing one hundred and four acres, more or less, situated in said County, described in a deed from Samuel Gleason and Margaret A.
