I notice on Exhibit F. L. S. #4, a notation in pencil "not to be presented before March 14" 1901, will you state in whose handwriting this notation is and if you can what the same means?

It is in my handwriting & as I now recollect it represents an understanding between us at the time that this check should not be presented for payment before that date & I believe this was arranged in that way because it was not convenient for me to pay the whole amount at that date, and I believe Mr. Hill fixed the date when he would need the money which is the date of the notation when it was to be presented.
