This Deed made this second of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty one by Elias Weyant and Elizabeth Weyant, his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred dollars, we the said Elias Weyant and Elizabeth Weyant, his wife, do grant unto Mary M. Smith of the County and State aforesaid all the two tracts of land, which were conveyed to the said Elias Weyant by Josiah Hutton and Mary A. C. Hutton his wife by deed bearing bearing date of the twenty ninth day of August in the year nineteen hundred and twenty one, said land lying in Frederick County, on the Public Road leading from Hotters Station to Rocky Ridge and containing seventeen acres one rood and eighteen square perches of land, more or less by reference to a deed from Andrew Fitz and Mary his wife to James C. Valentine dated the twentieth day of March A. D. 1854, and recorded in Liber C. S. No. 6. Folio 128. & 129, one of the Land Record of Frederick County, with more fully and
