To the Honorable, the Judges of Said Court:-
Your oratrix Complaining, Saith:-

1. That Charles Broadrup, late of Frederick County, died on or about the 19th day of March in the year 1907, intestate seized and possessed of various tracts, parts of tracts and parcels of land situated in said County as follows.

(1) A tract of $36\frac{3}{4}$ acres of land, more or less, described in the deed thence to the said Charles Broadrup, from Peter Morgan and George H. Morgan, dated November the 4th, 1856, and recorded in Liber E. S. No. 9, folio 27, one of the Land Records of Frederick, a Certified Copy whereof is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1, and with all other Exhibits herewith filed, is prayed to be taken and considered as part of this bill.

(2) A tract of 69 acres of land, more or less, conveyed to the said Charles Broadrup by Henry Henck, Sheriff, by deed dated August the 2nd, 1842, and recorded in Liber B. S. No. 15 folio 521 one of said Land Records a Certified Copy whereof is herewith filed, as part hereof, marked Exhibits No. 2.

(3) A tract or parcel of 9 acres of land, more or less, being part of a tract or a parcel of 11 acres, more or less, conveyed to the said Charles Broadrup, Joshua Hill, Trustee, by deed dated May the 11th, 1847, and recorded in H. S. J. No. 6, folio 100, one of said Land Records, a Certified Copy whereof is herewith filed as part hereof marked Exhibit No. 3, but of which a parcel of 2 acres, more or less, was conveyed away by the said Charles Broadrup to Charles H. McAllister dated, by deed dated April the 2nd 1862, and recorded in Liber B. S. J. No. 7, folio 627, one of said Land Records, a Certified Copy whereof is herewith filed as part hereof, marked Exhibit No. 4.

(4) A parcel of land containing 3 rods and 39 square perches, more or less, conveyed to the said Charles Broadrup by Joshua Hill and wife, by deed dated May
