C. Peters, by deed March the 26th, 1874, and recorded in Liber T. S. No. folio 634, one of said Land Records, a Certified Copy whereof is herewith filed as part hereof. Marked Exhibit No. 14, but a parcel of $\frac{1}{2}$ acre and 12 square perches more or less of the lands conveyed by said deed, was conveyed by the said Charles Broadrup to William Stahl by deed dated April 1st, 1886, and recorded in Liber W. J. P. No. 1, folio 287, one of said Land Records, a Certified Copy whereof is herewith filed as part hereof. Marked Exhibit No. 15.
