3. That the real estate aforesaid, cannot be divided without great loss and injury to the estate of the said Henry S. Cuttail, deceased, it not being susceptible of partition among the parties; and it would be to the best interests and advantage of all concerned, especially those of the said infant defendants, to have the property aforesaid sold under a decree of your Honorable Court, and the proceeds arising from said sale be distributed among the parties entitled thereto according to their respective interests and subject to the direction of your Honorable Court, after the payment of all costs and expenses attendant upon such sale.

4. That the Said Complainants have authorized the filing of this Bill, and have directed that the proceeds arising from said sale, in the event it should be decreed, in so far as their respective interests are concerned, shall be distributed to Ida S. Cuttail, widow; all of which will appear by reference to the paper writing herewith filed marked Exhibit A, and prayed to be taken and considered as a part hereof.

To the end, therefore

1. That your Honor will pass a decree directing that the real estate aforesaid, be sold by a Trustee appointed by your Honorable Court; and direct that the proceeds arising from said sale be distributed among the parties entitled thereto according to their respective interests.

2. That your Honor will grant unto the Complainants such further and other relief as the nature of their case may require and to your Honor shall seem just and right.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your Complainants the writ of Subpoena directed to the Said defendants Henry Cuttail, Harper Cuttail, Roy Cuttail, Wm Cuttail, Walter Cuttail, Evelyn Cuttail, and Ethel Cuttail, all infants, and residents of Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them, and each of them to be and appear before your Honorable Court either in person or by Solicitor, on some certain day to be named therein, answer the premises aforesaid by and perform such a decree as may be passed therein.
