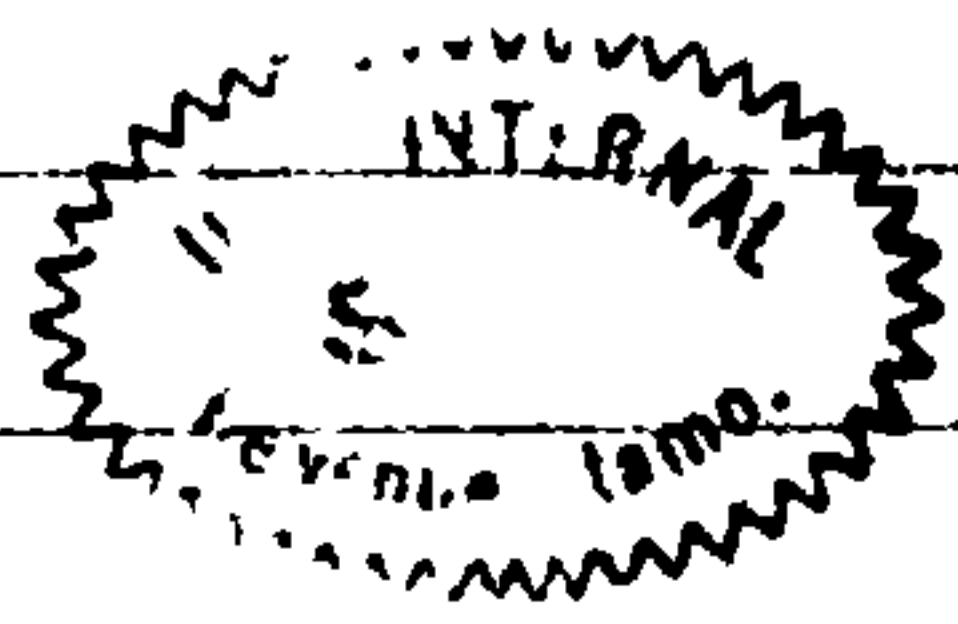

At the request of Hiram Cutrail the following deed is received for Record and recorded March 6th, 1899, at 1.0 O'Clock 5 minutes, P. M.

This deed made this 6th day of March A. D. in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety nine by us Daniel F. Snyder and Margaret A. Snyder his wife of Frederick County, State of Maryland. Witness: That for and in consideration of the sum of Six thousand and four hundred and forty seven dollars (\$6447.00), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said Daniel F. Snyder and Margaret Snyder his wife do hereby grant unto Hiram S. Cutrail in fee simple, all that tract or parcel of land with the improvements thereon, situated, lying and being in Urbana District along the Urbana Turnpike Road in Frederick County, State of Maryland, and further described with course and distance, as follows, being part of a tract of land called "Altogether", and a part of a tract called "Abrons choice" it being part of the same land which was conveyed to the said Daniel F. Snyder by Margaret Kramer by deed dated 23rd day of January 1879, and recorded in Liber T. L. #12, folio 194 re., one of the land records of Frederick County, Md, also all that tract or parcel of land containing 34 acres 3 rods and 10 perches, which
