The Bill of Complaint of Susan Keight, widow  
of Baltimore City, in the State of Maryland, Henry M.  
Kiddoff, bachelor, Emma J. Smith unmarried, Franklin  
Buchanan Smith and Anne G. Smith his wife of  
Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Plaintiffs  
against Eliza P. Kiddoff of Frederick County, Maryland,  
Defendant, in your Honorable Court exhibited, Humbly  
Complaining said Plaintiffs, your orators respectfully  
represents unto your Honor:-

1st. That a certain George A. Kiddoff, bachelor,  
late a resident of Frederick County, Maryland, died at  
said County on or about the fifth day of November  
in the year nineteen hundred and seven, intestate  
no heirs and possessed at the time of his death  
of certain valuable Real Estate Situate in said County,  
Consisting of a Lot, part of a lot or parcel of ground  
Situate, lying and being on the North Side of West  
Second Street in Frederick City in said County, and  
state and designated by its Number Three hundred and  
forty six (346), fronting on said Street thirty feet more  
or less and extending Northwardly the same width for  
a distance of one hundred and ninety six feet and  
six inches, and improved with two stone story brick  
dwelling houses, altogether valued at about \$4500= and  
being the same real estate which was conveyed to the  
said George A. Kiddoff in his lifetime by Lewis M.  
Kiddoff and Eliza P. Kiddoff his wife by deed dated  
the 19th day of May in the year 1896, a duly  
Certified Copy of which deed as recorded among the  
the Land Records of said Frederick County in Lib  
J. L. J. No. 14, folio 126, is herewith filed as part  
hereof and marked Exhibit 'a' and which at the  
death of said George A. Kiddoff passed to his said  
heirs at law.
