The Petition of Eldridge F. Noice of Frederick County, State of Maryland respectfully shews to your Honors, that by the proceedings and decree passed in No. 4057, Equity in Your Honorable Court on the 22nd day of November 1876. a farm containing 99 1/2 acres of land was laid off for Mary Allen Noice widow of Solomon Noice as and for her dower that by the terms of the decree aforesaid the terms of the sale of that portion of said real estate set apart and laid off as the dower right of Mary Ann Noice widow of Solomon Noice be fixed by the future order of your Honorable Court.

2. That the said decree appointed Judson J. Nelson and Charles H. Ross Trustees to make sale of the real Estate deemed to be sold.

3. That the said Noice the widow occupied the real estate then laid off as her dower up until the sixth day of January in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty Seven, when the said Mary Ann Noice departed this life.

4th. That your Petitioner and others - desire that the said farm be sold under the order and decree of your Honorable Court and that the proceeds be distributed among the parties entitled according to the provisions of the original decree and to that end

Your Petitioners pray your Honorable Court to pass and order fixing the time of the sale of said land as provided in the original decree; and as in duty so.
