

## No 5362 Equity.

"Venus" and running thence South eighty two degrees East Seventy two perches. South six degrees East Seventy three perches. South twenty degrees West one hundred & thirty three perches North fifty nine and a quarter degrees West one hundred and forty five and a half perches to the end of one hundred and forty perches on the given line of said tract of land, then by a straight line to the first place of beginning containing Ninety eight acres, one quarter and eighteen square perches of land more or less, including Town or the same time, two acres of land which were heretofore conveyed to a certain Cornelius Shivers, and also including about one and a half acres of land more or less, running foul in the adjoining land.
