 tract or parcel of land Situate in said County
 Beginning for the same at the end of the
 2nd line or North fifteen and three quarters degrees
 East thirty six or four tenths perches line of a deed
 from William James and wife to a certain Samuel
 B. Eppley for part of the same tract and parcel
 of land it being part of a tract of Land
 called "Addition to Whiskey Ridge" and running
