10. That said Mollie L. Denilbis was the Administratrix of the personal estate of said Preston S. Denilbis and said Geo. William Buckley, who also acted as her agent in the settlement of said personal is now dead.

Therefore your petitioner prays,
1st. That the proceeds of sale of said real estate when such sale shall be made, shall be applied so far as the same be necessary to the payment of the said claims of your Petitioner.

2. That your Petitioner may have all such other and further relief to which she may be entitled.
